

Program	Goal
Dance to Learn	Dance to Learn (D2L) is a four-year interdisciplinary and inclusive dance curriculum and training program for teaching artists, with the goal to advance dance education for grades 2-5 in schools and community settings.
Theater to Learn	Dodge Theatre to Learn (DT2L) is an integrated theater and language arts curriculum and professional learning program with the goal provide grade 2 through 5 classroom teachers with professional development to incorporate theatre and dramatic play into classroom teaching.
Creativity Consultant Project	Creativity Consultant Project (CCP) is a professional development model for classroom teachers with the goal to support a growing understanding of arts-integration practices and the importance of collaborative partnerships.
YA Arts Education Scholarships	YA Arts Education Scholarships are designed to bring extraordinary and inspiring performances, hands-on student workshops and/or professional learning to schools. The goals of the program are to provide students and teachers with customized high quality arts experiences, opportunities to understand the cultural importance of the arts and creativity and to connect to classroom culture and life. Each scholarship school receives a variety of YA programming incorporated into their school year.
Artists in Education Residency	The Artists in Education (AIE) residency grant is a unique partnership bringing dynamic, in-depth arts education programs to New Jersey Schools. The goal of the program is to bring teaching artists and classroom teachers together to co-create long term residencies (20+ days) to help students and teachers engage in and learn about the creative process.
Performance	YA Performances work to increase student and teacher access and active participation in live professional performance.
Workshops	YA Workshops work to ensure students and teachers have access and active participation in high quality, integrated arts experiences with professional teaching artists.
Creative Beginnings	Creative Beginnings is a professional learning initiative that promotes school readiness by supporting Early Childhood Educators to create innovative arts experiences for students aged 2-5.
NRG Creatively STEAM Scholarships	The NRG Creatively STEAM Scholarships provide selected schools with year-long arts education programming rooted in STEAM. The goal is to provide performance, student workshops and professional learning to leverage an interdisciplinary approach to increase learning around science, technology, engineering, the arts and math.
Adopt A School	The YA Adopt A School programs work to establish and sustain arts programming in schools that have little or no arts programming. Through student workshops, professional learning and performance students and teachers gain increased art form knowledge and skills, an appreciation for how the arts support and nurture creativity and imagination and an increased awareness and appreciation for different cultures backgrounds and points of view.

Eat Right Now	Eat Right Now provides nutrition education programming for the Philadelphia School District. YA is a sub-contractor in this work, providing over 200 nutrition education performances ("Jump with Jill" and "Healthier Ever After") over the course of the school year, for grades 2-6
Jump with Jill	Jump with Jill is a rock-n- roll nutrition performance with the goal to advance student understand of healthy lifestyle choices. With funding from Robert Wood Johnson Foundation, Johnson and Johnson, Aetna and Pottstown (Fdn.) we have provided hundreds of Jump with Jill performances in New Jersey and Pennsylvania. The level of assessment of student understanding that we implement is aligned with the funder requirements.
